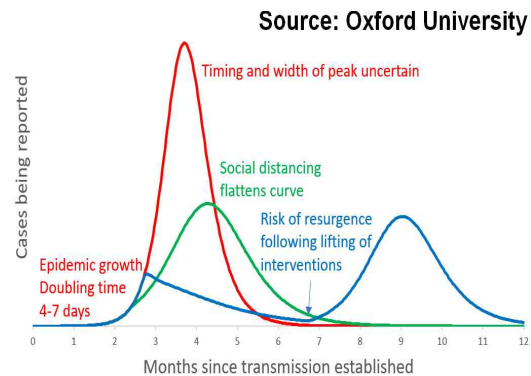


How do we at INSEVIS deal with the COVID 19 pandemic?

New status reports on the corona virus SARS-CoV-2 reach us daily and as a matter of course also for us as a responsible S7-system supplier this topic is highly relevant.

In order to meet the continuously changing situation in the best possible way, we are in constant exchange with our business partners and employees to respond to new circumstances.

We fully support public efforts through our actions, to slow the spread of this disease.



The health and well-being of our employees, customers and suppliers is our top priority.

In view of the evolving situation, we have taken extensive measures to ensure the safety and productivity of all.

- Our employees were sensitized to take precautionary hygiene measures (e.g. use of disinfectants, avoidance of shaking hands, etc.). There are also detailed instructions on how to proceed with suspicious cases.
- We have made the protection of our colleagues more restrictive through visitor management for external visitors. We carry out a risk assessment for every absolutely necessary visitor and only receive visitors in emergencies.
- We reduce our travel activities to business necessary and business critical trips and consistently avoid risk areas.

A second important aspect is to guarantee our business operations in order to fulfil our delivery and service obligations even under these exceptional conditions.

Due to our organisational structure (outsourcing of personnel-intensive processing and testing, in-house final assembly, flexibly trained teams) our business operations are currently secure.

- We believe that we are well prepared for the current situation thanks to extensive stockpiling. Only already postponed deliveries of 3.5"/5.7" and 15.6" fronts from the start of the corona crisis in China have led to an increase in delivery times for affected products.
- Our responsible persons are in constant exchange with customers, sales partners and manufacturing partners for permanent monitoring and re-evaluation of the current situation.
- We have developed a contingency plan to ensure core service functions should the situation deteriorate further (e.g. by drastically restricting the movement of goods, unrestricted curfews, etc.)

Let us work together to master the difficult time ahead and let us not forget that this requirement is also a test of our character and social responsibility.
